Dear parents and caregivers

As you would be aware, the Premier has announced we are in a three-day lockdown from 4:00pm Saturday 31 July 2021 until 4:00pm Tuesday 3 August 2021. The [Queensland Government website](#) will be updated with further information on the lockdown, including all restrictions and maps of the affected areas.

School operations

Only students of essential workers or in the care of Child Safety can attend school during the lockdown period. Essential workers are those who are attending a worksite. The tuckshop will not be open, so they will need to bring lunch. On Monday these students will be given activities to do and on Tuesday they will engage in the remote learning program whilst at school. Students will not have access to their teachers. Students will be required to assemble in the hall at the start of each day for allocation to a supervision room.

There is now a requirement that all high school **students are to wear face masks** while at school. Students must bring their own mask.

Continuity of learning

Monday is a planning day for teachers and no remote learning will occur. However, students wishing to do so may access a wide range of resources via the department's learning@home website - <https://education.qld.gov.au/curriculum/learning-at-home>.

On Tuesday, remote learning will occur using the normal Tuesday timetable. Teachers will send an email to their classes on Monday to inform students on what is required for Tuesday's lesson. The class OneNote will provide the resources and activities for the lesson.

There will be no excursions for the foreseeable future and some exams may need to be rescheduled.
