### Statement of Commitment

The **VET Trades @Nerang Program** is senior secondary education done differently. The program is designed to **facilitate** authentic trade based learning (on campus at the Gold Coast Resource Industry Trade Skills Centre), and real world experience by way of **regular** structured work placement with host employers over the duration of the Program.

Success in the program entails the following:

- Completion of core subjects Maths and English plus nationally recognised qualifications (*Certificate I in Construction, Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways*) and *1 elective Certificate II in Furnishings Pathways or, Certificate II in Engineering Pathways*
- *Completion of a First Aid Certificate and Construction White Card*
- Completion of PT (personal training sessions)
- Completion of **regular** work experience in a number of fields. **Note: It is the responsibility of students and their families to source placements and arrange suitable transport to and from placement locations**
- Adherence to Nerang State High Schools behaviour, assessment and uniform policies (including uniform policy amendments for Trade Program students – *see below for trade uniform details*)
