


# Opening a Teacher Video in OneNote Online




You have been working through your *Class Notebook* using *OneNote Online* and wish to open a video lesson from your teacher.

Step 1: Go to the **Concept** you are working on


Step 2: Double click on the **embedded video**.  
(Depending on your computer, your video icon may look slightly different).

### Step 3: Simply Select *Download*



**Step 4:** The video will automatically *download* to your computer.

Once it has downloaded, click on the downloaded file to play.

**Content:** What is a clause

- A clause is a group of related words that contains both a subject and a verb.
- It tells us about an action and the people or things involved.
- All clauses contain a verb.
- Clauses have a subject – the person or thing doing the action of the verb.
- Clauses usually have an object – the person or thing receiving the action of the verb
- For example:

The car	struct	the fence
Subject	Verb	Object

**Content:** Two Types of Clauses

There are two types of clauses:

- A **main clause** can stand alone as a complete sentence.
- A **subordinate clause** is a group of words that also contains a subject and a verb, but it is not a complete thought.
