Flexischools online ordering is available for canteen purchases: www.flexischools.com.au. Students and parents are able to place an order with the canteen before school for collection at either first or second break. We encourage online ordering so the students don't miss out if they have a club, rehearsal or meeting to attend in the breaks, or if they want something specific to eat.
