Our canteen is a cafeteria style, where students choose an item and take it to the register. We accept cash or EFTPOS.

Students and parents are able to place an order with the canteen before school for collection at either first or second break. We encourage online ordering so the students don't miss out if they have a club, rehearsal or meeting to attend in the breaks, or if they want something specific to eat.
