



Senior Geography Excursion - Numinbah Valley Environmental Education Centre

Currently our Year 11 and 12 Geography students are studying Land Cover Transformations. In this unit, students develop an understanding of changes to the biophysical environment over time, with a particular focus on human activity and climate change. In this unit, students are required to complete a case study and fieldwork where they investigate natural and man-made processes that have resulted in change to Earth's land cover.

Students will complete fieldwork at the Numinbah Valley Environmental and Education Centre. They will complete an investigation of the banks of the Hinze Dam which has resulted in a Lantana infestation and develop an understanding of the consequences of this environmental hazard. Students will then use data collected in their field report.
