



NAPLAN INFORMATION

Dear Parents/Guardians

Year 7 and Year 9 students will be sitting the NAPLAN paper test Tuesday 11 May, Wednesday 12 May and Thursday 13 May. All Year 7 & 9 students along with students in Years 3 and 5 across Australia are required to participate in the National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN).

Students on these days will be assessed through five assessment tasks in the areas of Reading, Writing, Language Conventions (Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation) and Numeracy (Calculator and Non-Calculator).

Why do we do NAPLAN? The NAPLAN testing gives us nationally benchmarked data on the two years between Year 7 to Year 9. NAPLAN is only a small measure of your student's achievement, however at Nerang State High School, we use the information we gather from our schools performance to go back and review the success of learning strategies that we have implemented to determine what areas we need to improve or focus on in the area of numeracy and literacy. Teachers use results to better identify students who would benefit from greater challenges or extra support.

We make every effort to minimise any anxiety your student may have about the NAPLAN test. Your student will sit the test each day in the same room, with the same teacher reading the instructions. In most cases, it will be your child's English or Mathematics teacher supervising the test.

All eligible Year 7 and 9 students at Nerang State High School must sit for the tests unless they are exempt or withdrawn by parents/guardians. Students may qualify for an exemption because of:

- Their lack of proficiency in the English language;
- Significant intellectual and/or functional disability;
- If the parents/guardians believe the test is in conflict with their religious beliefs or there is a philosophical objection to completing the test.

Parents/Guardians wishing to apply for an exemption must complete the *Application for Test Exemption* form in accordance with point 1 or 2 above, or the *Notice of parent withdrawal* form for point 3. These forms can be obtained from the school administration office and must be returned to the school office no later than Friday 7 May 2021.
