Dear Parents/Caregivers

SENIOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING (SET) PLAN YEAR 10 2026

Year 10 commences a new phase of learning for your child as they move from the Junior School to the Senior School and beyond. Early planning helps students consider their options, work towards achieving their goals and enhance their post-school outcomes. In Year 10, students will complete a Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan. To support your child in Year 9, we commence this SET Planning process as follows:

SET Planning Folder: Students will receive the folder in Form Class on Wednesday Week 3 Term 3 (30 July). The folder contains relevant information regarding the process.

Subjects to Study: Students study English and Maths for the year and select six elective subjects studied three per semester.

Subject Information: In weekly SET Planning lessons and Thursday morning fortnightly assemblies, students have been provided with information about the subjects being offered, prerequisites for course entry and future pathway options.

Mentors: Each student is allocated a Mentor who will assist the student with their decision-making.

SETP Meetings and Subject Selection: Each student will meet with their Mentor for approximately 10 to 15 minutes. The meeting will occur on Wednesday 20 August or Wednesday 27 August. Students will locate the meeting time on their SET Plan folder.

Parent/Carers: You are **not required** to attend the interviews; however, **you can assist** your child as follows:

- Speak to your child about their interests, the subjects they like and the subjects they are good at.
- Discuss the type of job/career they would like – this may change over the next couple of years.
- Look at the Subjects on offer and discuss with your child possible selections.
- **Complete the SET Planning Checklist Form** with your child **prior to the interview**.
- Feel free to contact your child's mentor – emails are on the school website.
- Remind your child about their meeting.
- Upon completion of the meeting, your child will bring home the completed Subject Selection Form. Check over the form and **return by Friday 30 August** to your mentor.
