Dear Parents/Carers

YEAR 11 2023 STUDENT EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAM (SETP)

The Student Education and Training Program is a career education and subject selection program that prepares your child for their future work choices. To date, the school has conducted a number of career planning activities. Part of the Program is a Careers Expo; however, due to renovations the venue is still to be confirmed. Details of SETP are outlined below and include the subject selection process and information regarding the new Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) and Tertiary Entrance Systems that were introduced for senior students in 2019.

Interviews for Student Education and Training (SET) Plan are being held in **Week 1 and 2, Term 4**. These interviews will be conducted by school personnel (Mentors) who will assist you and your child with career planning and Year 11 subject selection.

THE NEW SYSTEM

In 2019, a new Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) and Tertiary Entrance System was introduced for senior students. The introduction of the new ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank) replaced the OP (Overall Position) as the standard pathway to tertiary study for Queensland Year 12s in 2020. Subjects contributing to the ATAR will include an external exam. There have also been changes in the requirements to achieve the QCE. - Ask your child about the class that has assisted them to identify their interests and career, education and training options.


